As chair of the Pathfinder Greenhouse Project Laura co-ordinates the ordering and sale of the plants, and when the plants arrive, she plans the timing and planting of the seeds and plugs. With the advent of Covid, Laura went almost daily to water/plant/transplant hundreds of seedlings and plugs that had been started in January. Because of her efforts the sale was successful and returned a nice profit to the MG program. A MG since 2004, Laura has also been on the Governor's Mansion project, the education committee, a County 76 member, and mentored 6 new master gardeners.

2020 Rookie of the Year Tina Coley



2020 Project of the Year Argenta


The Argenta project started in 2008 and consists of eight corners located at 4th and Main in downtown Little Rock.

Planters are changed seasonally, and plants and bulbs that are taken out are then shared with local residents. The 10 master gardeners on the project love getting the constant feedback and appreciation from local merchants and residents.



2020 County Agent of the Year Randy Forst

Pulaski County is delighted to nominate our own Randy Forst as County Agent of the Year. Randy has had a direct impact on the success and growth of the 550-member Master Gardener program. Since coming to Pulaski County, he has implemented the P.E.S.T. program (liaison between the projects and their host facility and a means for the Board to evaluate and support our 31 projects). He also was one of the original planners on the **Demonstration Garden at the 4-H Center in** Ferndale. Randy supports Master Gardeners by teaching statewide through zoom sessions and TV appearances. In his personal life, Randy is a farmer with herds of Dorper sheep, cows and various chickens. Randy is an exceptional human being, always cheerful and with an ability to encourage others to learn and grow.
