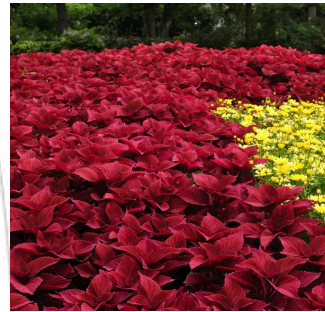

- Graffiti Red Penta



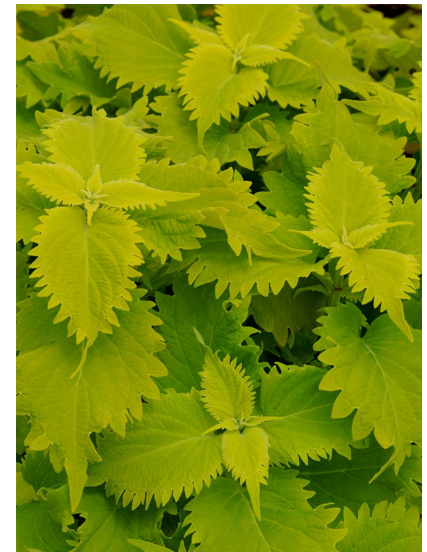
2017 Plants

- Vista Pink Bubblegum Petunia



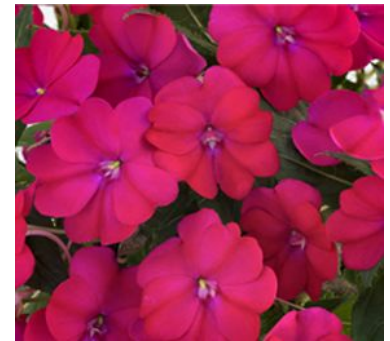
2018 Plants
