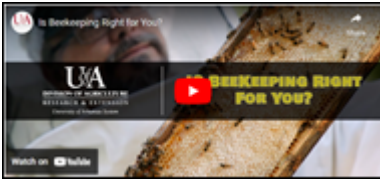

**Deadline to submit photos is Friday, June 22,
2023.**

- All works must be original to the exhibitor.
- Photographs may be color, black and white or sepia.
- All photographs must include plant material.
- All photographs must have been taken inside the borders of the state of Arkansas.
- All decisions by the five selected judges are final. Photographs will be individually reviewed starting after entry deadline.
- Photographs will be reviewed on the following merits: creativity, composition and technical merit.
- ***LANDSCAPE DIMENSION ONLY, PLEASE!***

Only four (4) entries per person (one per season). Meaning only one Winter (WI), one Spring (SP), one Summer (SU), and one Fall (FA) photo may be entered in the 2024 MG Calendar Contest.

All photos need be a higher mb count for the resolution to be considered for reproduction by the offset printing method.

Photos must be sent as an attachment(s) to an email document. ***“Drag and Drop” files will not be accepted.***

Photos **MUST** be properly named in the JPEG format only to be accepted for consideration. Any other file type will be rejected.

This is an example of how the photo(s) must be labeled using your own information:

Your name, your county name, name of entry, season of photo.
