1. To reserve space contact:

- 2. Exhibitors may enter more than one design within the Artistic Division.
- Entries may be placed from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Friday, April 26th and from 7:00 a.m. until 9:45 a.m., Saturday April 27th. Exhibits must remain in place until 4:00 p.m. April 27th and then must be promptly removed.
- 4. Exhibitors need not be Central Arkansas Iris Society Members.
- Each exhibitor will have a table surface approximately 24" wide and 30" deep (1/4 of a table). No height limitations.
- 6. Iris flowers are required in all designs and must be dominant.
- No artificial plant material or coloring of fresh plant material will be allowed. Dried plant material may be colored.
- Judging will be done by qualified judges with experience in design judging and appointed by the Artistic Chair. Judges' decisions are final. Crystal will be placed by the Artistic Chair.

Runner-Up for Best Design - Crystal for the second highest scoring entry in the Design Section.


